# Algebra 2 Pleasant Valley High School Course Information: 2019-2020

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## • Course Description

The purpose of this course is to satisfy the Algebra II requirement of the Common Core Mathematics Standards adopted by the State of Iowa. This upper level course extends what students have learned in Algebra I and Geometry as well as introducing more advanced topics and should prepare most students for Pre-Calculus or Probability/Statistics.

The kind of learning activities in which students will engage can be described as cooperative group investigations, partner collaboration, or individual work. Each is designed to help students understand and explain the key concepts presented in this course. Students will experience hands-on activities, incorporate real world applications, and participate in class discussions with open-ended problem solving, while using 21<sup>st</sup> century skills such as: creativity/innovation, communication, collaboration, critical thinking, problem solving, and decision making.

- Unit 3: Modeling with Functions
- Unit 4: Inferences and Conclusions from Data
